癌症的預防、 探測與普查

給全港市民的建議

及早實行一個周全的防癌大計，
可能是您一生中最重要的投資。

避免食用高「熱量密度」的食物和高糖飲品 (尤其是加糖、低糖和高糖的加工食物)

- 高「熱量密度」食物是指每100克含有25-37%熱量的食物，包括巧克力、薯片、薯條、漢堡包、炸雞和大部分快餐等。
- 選擇較健康的食物來取代高糖、高糖和高熱量的食物，有助減輕體重肥胖的危機。



吃不同種類的蔬菜、豆類和豆類

- 將上列的食物(如菠菜、鞍菊和豆類等)為主輔，使它們的營養能互相補充，有助降低癌症。
- 每日應食五份蔬菜(每日200g)，一份等於半碗綠豆(煮熟計)或一份中型水果。



盡量少吃紅肉和加工肉類

- 每星期不應吃多過600克(約1磅)紅肉(以煮熟計)的紅肉和加工肉類。
- 紅肉包括牛、豬、羊肉(如漢堡肉、夾治牛肉、豬扒和豬排等)。
- 加工肉類是指煙燻、鹽鹹或添加防腐劑的食物，包括火腿、臘肉、意大利臘腸、熱狗、香腸、臘腸等。



癌症的預防、探測與普查

限制飲酒

- 癌症風險免過高；
- 以飲酒，男士每天不應多過兩杯，女士每天不應多過一杯(一杯約等於330毫升啤酒或150毫升葡萄酒)。



不建議食用高鹽分或鹽醃的食物

- 每日不應攝食多過6克(2.4茶匙)的鹽，因為大部分的鹽來自每日攝食的多鹹加工食品，選購時請真正所標；
- 攝食高鹽食物會增加患癌尤其是胃癌的風險。



不要依賴營養補充劑來防癌

- 維持一個健康的飲食模式是較服用營養補充劑，更能有效預防癌症；
- 從食物和活動中所得的營養是最佳選擇的，一個均衡的飲食模式應能供給我們所需的營養。




最理想是以母乳餵養嬰兒至六個月大

- 研究證實母乳含有降低嬰兒日後患癌和嬰兒體重的機會。



本港結核菌感染和肺癌 (20歲或以上) 的發病趨勢與推算 (1990-2015年)



結核菌感染及肺癌的發病率均呈上升趨勢。

乳癌

- 儘管為高發的婦女癌症，但乳癌並非致命；
- 當腫瘤較小並不到肺部在進行光線檢查出來的腫瘤較小，一定療程後能取得顯著的生存率；
- 約百分之四十國家的腫瘤學對測試研究論證，與沒有接受乳房攝影大光檢查者相比，接受檢查者死於乳癌的比率下降大約20%-50%以上的婦女減幅較大，而40-49歲婦女則減少；
- 可靠、靈敏的乳癌篩檢與研究新技術，證實乳房攝影大光檢查能為華人或亞洲婦女提供最佳篩檢方法。

癌症的預防、探測與普查

- 目前為止，由於並未確定乳房攝影大光檢查的益處多過風險，故仍未有足夠證據支持為健康婦女進行全乳攝影大光檢查；
- 婦女若考慮進行篩檢應守方案，40歲或以上婦女每年接受乳房攝影大光檢查，進行篩檢量，事出應先所有的益處、風險和不足的處以作明智的選擇；
- 若婦女選擇接受檢查，應由中級開始，因非癌症的20%至30%的婦女，有高達27%的患病機會發生在45歲以下的女性；
- 患乳癌的風險較一般人高的婦女(如有家族乳癌病史者)應與醫生商量，了解清楚應否接受檢查，應作時間及每次檢查的間隔的時數，並討論有關的風險和利益，使她們們選擇乳攝影大光檢查的益處會更大；
- 目前仍未能確定什麼年紀的婦女應再接受乳房攝影大光檢查，但大多數專家不贊主動接受50歲以上的婦女進行檢查；
- 亞洲女性往往有較小、致密性強，故可考慮乳房攝影大光攝影檢查後再進行，以作升高的準確性；
- 然而，不論何種年齡的女性，在每月的任何時間，都應留意自己乳房的狀況，如發現明顯變化，應立即通知醫生。

癌症統計數字

根據世界衛生組織 (WHO) 表示，在全球每年一千萬宗新癌症個案中，多於三成的癌症是可以預防的。若市民能維持正確的飲食方法和實踐健康的生活模式，癌症是可以避免的。但由於癌症早期大多沒有明顯症狀，加上市民對癌症認識不足而延誤求醫，便會減低治療機會。

目前癌症的治療成效關鍵在於早期發現，早期治療。作為二十一世紀的至FIT型人，怎樣才能早人一步，提高警覺作好預防。本會現誠邀閣下參與為期9個月的免費防癌輔導及諮詢服務，為市民作出探測及輔導（特別是家族性癌症病患者家屬）。

癌症探測及普查是甚麼？

癌症探測及普查是指及早識別癌症的病徵和症狀，或識別出已患病但未有病徵的人士，有助提早診斷和治療可以致命的癌症，雖然這些病徵和病狀不一定表示癌病存在，但可以令人提高警覺，注意身體出現的變化，並可以盡快尋找醫生診治。



普查計劃的流程

本會專業護士會為閣下個案進行分析，深入了解閣下的家族病歷，個人病歷，個人生活起居習慣，繼而評估閣下患上癌症的風險，並建議閣下應作何種詳細檢查，及早作出預防及探測，同時並定期跟進每一個的進展情況，並協助提供資料及評估個案的需要。

參加普查計劃的好處

本會推行的癌症探測及普查服務，目的是讓市民認識防癌的重要性及提醒市民應關注自己的身體狀況，在適當時候進行普查。本輔導計劃是特別為一般市民及高風險的癌症病患者家屬作出風險評估及監控，務求可改善市民的健康和生活質素。

防癌至助星

為鼓勵大家參與今次癌症輔導及諮詢服務，本會特設頒發「防癌至助星」證書以獎勵完成整個普查健康問卷輔導及諮詢的參與者。

病人須知

目的

提供現金資助及/或藥物資助予醫院管理局屬下公營醫院的癌症病人。按醫管局的藥物名冊內表列的自費藥物，他們須自費購藥以作化學治療 Chemotherapy 或標靶治療 Targeted Therapy (輔助治療 Adjuvant Therapy 除外)，而這些藥物並不納入「撒瑪利亞基金資助的安全網藥物援助計劃」。受本計劃所資助及/或資助的藥物，須根據本會最新公佈的「何鴻超教授紀念助醫計劃資助藥物表」為準。

申請資格

- 病人必須為有效香港身份證持有人(家長可代其年齡 18 歲以下的子女申請)。
- 病人須經由醫管局屬下 6 間公營醫院(東區尤德夫人那打素醫院、瑪嘉烈醫院、威爾斯親王醫院、伊利沙伯醫院、瑪麗醫院、屯門醫院)其中一間醫院腫瘤科中心的醫生推薦。
- 病人須將申請表格，連同一份個人經濟狀況遞交轉介醫院的醫務社工並接受入息審查。

現金資助 / 藥物資助

- 病人最高可獲資助 6 次療程，每次療程最高可獲港幣 \$3,000 元或藥物資助，病人須自行負擔療程不足的治疗費用。
- 資助療程會由生效日期起計；病人於獲批資助前的自費療程，將不可向本會追討資助。

- 病人最多可享有該計劃的援助一次。

- 獲資助的病人須遵守本計劃之「病人須知」所訂守則。

- 病人如欲申請藥物資助，需向所屬腫瘤科中心的醫生。

- 病人領取資助藥物或以現金資助購買所需藥物時，均須自負醫院管理局所收取的行政手續費。

- 若申請資助者提交的文件齊備，審批過程約需 14 天。

- 香港防癌會有決定及批核申請的權利。

Cancer victim gives a ray of hope to other patients

This is the second in our series on the 1989 Outstanding Young Persons Awards.

YOUNG people should have the courage to face obstacles in life as they are minimal when compared with the crisis of death.

Alice Cheung Pui-lan is qualified to make such a statement as she has finally gained victory in her fight against cancer.

Named one of the outstanding young persons of the year, Alice has won reputation for her voluntary work in anti-cancer activities.

"I am happy that my efforts have been appreciated and recognised by the public. It is a great encouragement for me to continue working for the welfare of society," said Miss Cheung.

Miss Cheung first joined the Hongkong Anti-Cancer Society in 1986 as a voluntary worker for the Hongkong Cancer Hot-line and has since become head of the Chinese-speaking division. Every evening she spends several hours at home offering counselling to numerous victims of the disease on the phone.

"Many cancer patients who called the hot-line service were to

While receiving treatment, she did not give her job as a teacher and as an assistant education officer (Administration) of the Education Department.

She obtained a Master's degree in translation from the Chinese University after her cancer had been diagnosed in 1983.

"I was lucky because I need not worry about my livelihood during the illness. But there are many more less fortunate ones whom I want to help," said Miss Cheung.

Miss Cheung said the illness changed her outlook about life.

"Death is not necessarily related to ageing, which is why I try to make the best use of each and every moment in my life," said Miss Cheung.

The 32-year-old workaholic is planning to further her study in counselling and psychology.

"My personal experience is a valuable asset for me to help other cancer patients. I want to have a solid theoretical foundation which would help me to provide a more thorough and systematic anti-cancer service," said Miss Cheung.

UICC World Cancer Declaration



The World Cancer Declaration 2008 was developed by the International Union Against Cancer (UICC), adopted by the World Cancer Summit 2008, and endorsed by the World Cancer Congress 2008.

A call to action from the global cancer community

We the global cancer community call on governments, international governmental organizations, the international donor community, development agencies, professional organizations, the private sector and all civil society to take immediate steps to slow and ultimately reverse the growth in deaths from cancer, by committing to the targets set out below and providing resources and political backing for the priority actions needed to achieve them.

Targets: by 2020

- Sustainable delivery systems will be in place to ensure that effective cancer control programmes are available in all countries
- The measurement of the global cancer burden and the impact of cancer control interventions will have improved significantly
- The number of training opportunities available for health professionals in different aspects of cancer control will have improved significantly
- Emigration of health workers with specialist training in cancer control will have reduced dramatically
- There will be major improvements in cancer survival rates in all countries

Priority actions

These targets are ambitious. During the past few years, however, there is growing evidence that concerted action can make a difference in a short time. We believe, therefore, that the targets can be achieved provided a number of priority actions are implemented:

Cancer prevention and early detection

- Increase efforts to reduce tobacco consumption by encouraging governments to fully implement and enforce the FCTC
- Raise awareness about the need for culturally sensitive cancer risk reduction campaigns, along with public and professional education about cancer warning signs. Push governments to implement policies that will support risk-reducing strategies at a community level and enable individuals to make more informed consumption choices and adopt healthier behaviour
- Encourage governments to implement measures to reduce people's exposure to environmental and occupational carcinogens
- Undertake actions to ensure that vaccines and other strategies that are shown to prevent cancer-causing infections are made more widely available

Achieving the Targets of the World Cancer Declaration - Concerted Efforts in Hong Kong

- Advocate for the provision of affordable screening programmes for which there is evidence of efficacy in the population in question. Undertake pilot projects that are designed to evaluate the feasibility and efficacy in populations in which the screening technology has not yet been tested

Cancer treatment

- Promote the development and use of cancer treatment guidelines that are relevant to local needs and resources. Ensure that sufficient treatment, rehabilitation and palliative care facilities and well-trained staff are available to meet the physical, social and emotional needs of patients with cancer
- Take steps to tackle the many barriers to optimal pain control. Work with governments to address the over-regulation of pain medicines. Cooperate with international organizations, including the International Narcotics Control Board and the World Health Organization, to ensure that global implementation of the UN's international drug control conventions do not unduly interfere with legitimate efforts to advance access to pain medicines for cancer patients in pain
- Work with the pharmaceutical industry to increase access to cancer medicines that are affordable and of assured quality
- Increase the number of health professionals with expertise in all aspects of cancer control by providing specialist training opportunities and fellowships to enable professionals to study in specialist settings

Background

The World Cancer Declaration 2008 is a tool to help cancer advocates bring the growing cancer crisis to the attention

the 2020 targets

- Given the huge variability in cancer burden and service provision throughout the world, the UICC will encourage members to use the World Cancer Declaration as a template to develop regional or national cancer declarations that can better reflect local needs and priorities and allow for more accurate quantification of targets where data exists
- The UICC will take responsibility for preparing a report every two years on the progress made towards achieving the 2020 targets. These reports will be presented at the biennial World Cancer Congress
